The membership application is open to high school students in South Texas. This is an invitation to participate in a Special Project. Students in Cameron and Hidalgo counties are invited to apply. We are accepting 9-12 new STYC members.

Your principal, counselor, a teacher and a parent, each need to sign off on your application.

Special Project, is the production of a video about iSol. The video would be told from the students' perspective, done smart, fun, informative, imaginative to help spur the deployment of fiber optic infrastructure in schools.

The video would illustrate the need for super speed bandwidth internet connection to the classroom. And to imagine what a class room might look like in ten years, in 2034. And ask if the twentieth first century has an expiration date.

STYC provides a unique opportunity for a high school student. Perhaps unlike any in Texas. As a member you have a platform to present your views and have a hand and voice in the making of public policy.

About time. Being part of this Special Project means investing some of your time. The iSol video though 8-10 minutes when done, involves these things:

Twelve or so hours over the summer, discussed a storyline. At the first meeting you decide on the storyline and began to sketch out the scenes. Groups can form to work on individual scenes and parts. Like the script, support graphic, clips, light and audio, on camera presence, practice, the shooting and the editing.

The iSol page has a lot of information to help with your video.

I want to take a moment to say that iSoI is an initiative of STYC. The idea grew from a discussion held tens years ago by a group of high school students and which was the first STYC gathering. It was held at Del Mar College in Corpus Christi. The following June they held the Dream Forward Dinner. In those days iSol struck a path to see access and optimum broadband in the classroom.

The video you help produce is a continuation to which you'll add your own voice, reflections and perspective. The video will be posted on the STYC and iCharla Podcast sites, on YouTube, and others. The video can be used to stimulate discussion and action.

Aim to preview a draft of the iSol video next August.

STYC members have access to the iCharla Podcast platform.

What do you get out of it. Contribution to your community. I will look into you receiving credit hours for community service and school recognition. I believe that communication skills can be learned, and how to look at an issue, how to discuss it, speak about it, how to present it. How to add and engage public policy.

Your work on the video will look good on a college or job application. On request, we can provide you a letter of recommendation. These letters have helped others make their name stand out.

What you get out of it is doing a good thing, your family and friends knowing what you helped do.
